




HELIODENT^{Plus} – easy intraoral X-raying

The direct path to easy operation.



Above all, the X-ray unit suitable for your practice must be easy to operate so that intraoral X-rays can be taken quickly and safely. The user interface must be understood intuitively and at first glance. The HELIODENT^{Plus} is a state-of-the-art intraoral X-ray system that is consistently oriented towards the requirements of your practice team. Durable and exactly tailored to your demands, it constantly ensures easy operation.

Overview instead of oversupply

Select an exposure type based on tooth symbols for the upper and lower jaw regions. Patient symbols for children help adapt the radiation dose to lower values. Blue LEDs indicate which functions you have selected. For special exposures, the preprogrammed exposure time can be altered manually (with the + and – keys). And the mere push of a button is also sufficient should you wish to change between suitable exposure times for digital and film X-ray as well as between different KV values.

Multicolour for multiple operating states

The colour of the display changes according to the system's current operating state. The four signal colours safely guide you through the exposure process:

- **Blue:** Neutral state, ready for exposure
- **Yellow:** Radiation active
- **White:** Cooling period, also displayed in system settings menu
- **Red:** An error has occurred

Saves time

Intelligent user interface design leads to faster exposures. HELIODENT^{Plus} is the best way to perform routine X-ray diagnosis.

Remote Control

The exposure process can also be controlled from outside the X-ray room – via a control panel with a manual release or via timer. The manual release can be detached from the control panel and used as a remote release.

HELIODENT X-ray images are detailed and feature an especially high contrast range, allowing excellent detail recognition. This is made possible by the high-frequency generator, which supplies high-energy radiation that is harder than the radiation produced by conventional single-pulse generators.




Exact alignment
